1. Applicants must submit a formal list of activities, work, volunteer experience, and extracurricular involvement.
2. Applicants must submit their most recent high school or college transcript.
3. Applications must include (as applicable):
 - a. Graduating high school seniors must be accompanied by a copy of the acceptance letter from the institution of higher learning.
 - b. Returning college students must be accompanied by an official document indicating intent to return (i.e., registration, receipt, room deposit, etc.).
4. Scholarships will be awarded based on the information included with this application, it is expected that the student will attend the school cited on the application.
5. It is understood that the term "academic year" begins with the fall semester.
6. Applications must be typed and submitted electronically. Transcripts and references can be emailed as attachments or submitted via mail.
7. Scholarship recipients must agree to provide the NHPA with a high-resolution profile picture and agree to its publication in our biannual magazine as well as on our social media platforms.
8. Applications **MUST** be received via email by May 15, 2021, 11:59 pm.
